Better fit for market



User-based licenses include better support for domains

User-based licenses will now allow jobs to be received from a specific domain including subdomains or, optionally, all domains. This means that customers don't need to know ahead of time how many domains they need for their users which greatly improves the customer on-boarding process.



Enterprise licenses get a 1000 user limit

The Enterprise license has been limited to 1000 users. It now supports subdomains, and optionally, all domains. New customers with more than 1000 users will need to purchase additional licenses. Existing customers will not be affected by this change.

Note – for handling authorization, it is recommended to use an API key, a feature that was introduced in the previous release of OL Connect Send.

Easier installation



Simplified driver download and installation

The whole installation process is simplified as the new installer can now be automatically configured via the web. This overcomes issues arising from clients having to locate and enter settings that control their connection to the server. Service providers can now make the settings available for download, control access to the settings by enforcing authentication and even prevent user tampering by locking them.

Users just download the installer, and simply copy/paste a URL to get the settings. The installer takes care of the rest.

Note – existing ways to install, i.e., loading settings from file, and configuring manually, are still also possible.

General improvements

- **Performance is improved** – The time needed to compress documents before they are transmitted has now been reduced. Submitting large jobs will therefore be faster.
- **Print queues status** - We have addressed the issue of print queues left behind when uninstalling.
